The new iPhone allows you to tune in to WiFi, 3G, EDGE and Bluetooth. You can listen to the radio and download or create podcasts wherever you are (p.176). Alternatively, select 'Airplane mode' and go into radio-blackout for flight safety.

#### Know where you are

The iPhone 3G can accurately determine your current location using GPS. You can also check out Google Maps and zoom in effortlessly to any location to view maps, high-quality satellite images (p.215), and even find traffic information.

#### Communicate

Plain old telephony is so passé: Visual Voicemail, Conference Calling, SMS and email are all covered in full. Plus see our top typing tips for the clever on-screen keyboard (p.57).
